## Why does the US enter WWI

#### Sinking of the Lusitania

- The British passage liner, \_\_\_\_\_\_, was torpedoed and sunk by German U-boats
- Germans claimed the ship was carrying ammunition
- 1,198 total killed
- 128 Americans
- Americans were outraged and edged towards war with Germany

#### **Unrestricted Submarine Warfare**

- The Arabic Pledge Germany promised not to sink unarmed liners.
- The Sussex sunk March, 1916
  - The - Germany promised to abide by the rules of search and seizure.

#### Telegram

- German foreign secretary sends a message to the German ambassador in Mexico
- Intercepted by British intelligence
- Note suggested that Mexico ally itself with Germany → Mexico would be given back New Mexico, Arizona, and Texas – lands taken from them by the U.S.

#### War is declared

- In February 1917, Germany went back to unrestricted submarine warfare and, soon after, sank six American merchant ships.
- On April 6, 1917, the United States declared war \_\_\_\_\_\_.

#### **Doughboys**
